--**Jail Ministry News:** We had a wonderful week at the jail. Two adults were there every night and in addition to a teen helper also. We also had adults there at times during each day so that every child who visited during the day received a Christmas bag. In 5 days, we gave 175 Christmas bags to these children! One of the biggest hits with the children, both young and old, was a little plastic clapper (about six inches long). Suzanne's company was getting rid of about 300 so we put one in each bag in addition to giving one to anyone who wanted one. They didn't make a loud noise, so Friday night (28 children), there was a lot of "clapping" at the

jail. In fact, one mother came to Suzanne bemoaning the fact that her one-year-old didn't have a clapper! He had one immediately! On behalf of all of you, however, I received a gift, the most precious of this Christmas. A father was at the monitor (wife and mother of three was in jail). I called his son over to get his bag. Then the boy's five-year-old and two-year-old sisters came to get their bags with his help. In a few minutes, the boy, age nine, came running back over to me with a piece of paper. Handing it to me, he gave me a BIG hug. In red magic marker, were written the words, "Thank you So much!" *This gift belongs to all of you:* Those who actually work at the jail, those of you who support with other activities such as calling, putting the calendar on the computer, cleaning the toys, supplying books, recruiting new volunteers, those of you students who are so important as volunteers, those of you parents who bring your teens to the jail to work, those of you who donate money, toys, and supplies, in fact, the boy's heartfelt thanks belong to all of you who are in any way involved in this ministry. Most important of all, are your prayers for this ministry. *Betty Hawkins*
