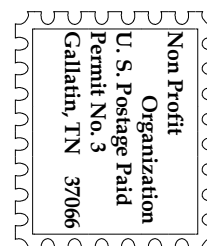

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Church Family,
I recently read this story in the Christ UMC Church Newsletter from McMinnville, Tn. I thought you would enjoy it and see how Methodists have been active in history. "In April, 1789, George Washington was inaugurated president of the United States. On May 29, 1789 a delegation of Methodists led by Bishop Asbury and Coke met with him in New York City, to assure the new government of Methodists loyalty. John Wesley, the spiritual founder of Methodism, had been very outspoken for King George III. Most of the preachers sent to America by Wesley had returned to England before the Revolutionary War. Thus Methodist had a reputation of being pro-England. The American Methodists in 1789 wanted the new government to understand that they were supportive.

The text of the Methodist statement to President Washington stated in part: We, the bishops of the Methodist-Episcopal Church, humbly beg leave, in the name of our society collectively in these United States, to express to you the warm feelings of our hearts, and our sincere congratulations, on your appointment to the presidency of these states. We are conscious

from the signal proofs you have already given, that you are a friend of mankind; and under this established idea, place as full a confidence to your wisdom and integrity, for the preservation of those civil and religious liberties which have been transmitted to us by the providence of God, and the glorious revolution, as we believe, ought to be reposed in man. We promise you our fervent prayers to the throne of grace, that God Almighty may endue you with all the graces and gifts of his Holy Spirit, that may enable you to fill your important station to his glory, the good of his church, the happiness and prosperity of the United States, and the welfare of mankind."

We need to remember as Methodist Christians to continue to pray for our civil and religious leaders. Our world is in great turmoil and needs the mighty hand of God to hold us steady and transform our lives. Prayer is the answer we need. May all the world see the need to return to God and seek peace. May Christ Jesus be lifted up and glorified as we seek to share His Gospel message.
