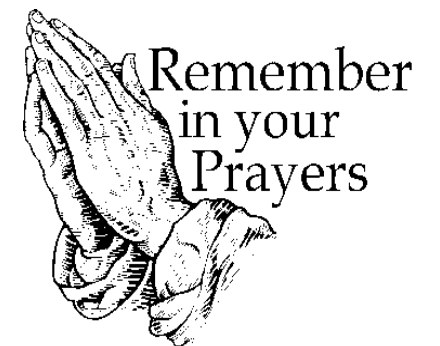

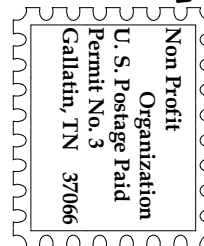

From the Pastor's Desk

I want to thank GFUMC for allowing me to be one of three lay delegates to the TN Annual Conference. Jerry and I would like to give you a few of the highlights. Called to Act: Make disciples, Transform the world The 2011 State of the Church Report to view information online or to download a PDF version of report, visit www.umc.org/sotc

The Development of Vital Congregations: We must fish in order to survive. We heard someone say, "Churches that don't fish, fight." We invite all to get involved in evangelism.

1. Programs vs. ministries. Ministries with children and youth are even more important than "programs," and the most effective churches engage in ministries with children and youth—and their parents.

2. Small groups. We must return to our Wesleyan heritage of small groups. Bishop Wills book "Waking To God's Dream" is highly recommended reading. He explains how this transformed the church he served in Florida. You can call the church office and read it ASAP.

3. Lay leadership. We heard someone say, "A church cannot move beyond its Lay Leadership". We must have high percentages of spiri-

tually engaged laity who assume leadership roles.

4. Worship. Sustain a mix of traditional and contemporary services in United Methodist churches. Increasingly, worship is communicated through music, drama, media, and the arts—and, beyond the worship hour, through the people's reading and conversations.

5. The pastorate. It calls for longer pastorates. Church growth correlates with longer pastorates. One recommendation—that the pastor "mentor" lay leaders.

It highlights that it is important to deploy lay people in ministries and that is where the pastor's coaching and mentoring are indispensable. Much of this we (GFUMC) are working on improving. We need your prayers, presence, gifts, and your service to help transform the world for Jesus Christ. We love Jesus and the United Methodist Church. The Church is the people we are in ministry with as we Share the Road, His Love, His Message, and Our Response. We pray that you will catch the vision of following Jesus, making disciples, and transforming the world (locally and globally).
