**--MEXICO MISSION TRIP:**

The Fall Volunteer In Mission trip to Mexico was a success. We made new friends at Divine Savior Methodist Church in Acayuca, Hidalgo, Mexico. There were 13 on the team from the US: Marti & Emily Brooks, Elba Dorris, Rachel Hurst, Pat Kinchloe, Nancy Petross from Carthage, Bob & Barbara Snell, Norm & Harletta Spencer, and Ron & Kay Wolford and their grandson Stephen. We had 3 Mexican interpreters, Methodists who have been with us for many years: Gibram, Marcos, and Martin.

The construction team worked on the second floor addition to the church. They mixed the stucco compound by hand, added stucco to the walls, and drilled grooves in the walls for the electrical conduit. They worked alongside the church members with a local maestro in charge.

The medical team held the clinic on Monday and Tuesday at a church member's home out in the country along a very rutted dirt road. On Monday a doctor, the daughter of church members, helped. On Wednesday through Friday morning the clinic was held at an unfinished house with a beautiful view of the valley surrounded by mountains. This house was also along another very rutted dirt road. But the people easily found the clinic.

A VIM team will be returning to Acayuca March 17-25, 2012. You are invited to join the team -- no skills necessary, except for doctors and nurses whom we need - and no Spanish required. Please talk with Elba, Rachel, and/or Bob or any of the former team members for more information or if you have questions.

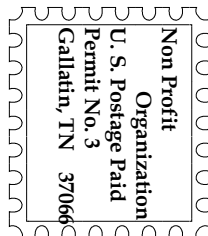

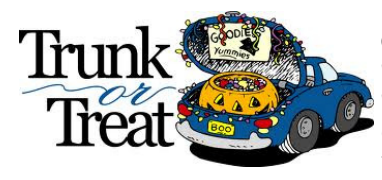
